By contrast, cultural psychology documents many ways in which thought and behavior are shaped by different cultural experiences. But cultural inquiries rarely consider evolutionary processes. Even after decades of intensive research, these two perspectives on human psychology have remained largely divorced from each other. But that is now changing - and that is what this book is about. *Evolution, Culture, and the Human Mind* is the first scholarly book to integrate evolutionary and cultural perspectives on human psychology.
