You scratch your head and ask your Mom if she thinks this is some kind of joke. “No” it’s not a joke. Your Grandfather was a good and kind man and would never play a joke on you. But I have no idea what these dates mean or what they are for. But I’m sure that you should celebrate them. Maybe some day you’ll understand their significance. So the years pass and you faithfully celebrate on these dates. And why not? After all, parties are fun. There is ice cream and silly songs and balloons and some games, and. The years roll on and you graduate from high school. It just so happens that the date is June 1st, one of the dates listed as a “party day” by your Grandfather’s letter, so you’re all set for a party anyway, so your family turns it into a graduation party. Just a co-incidence, you guess. You enroll in college and because you have to work part time, it takes longer than usual to graduation. When you finally put on your cap and gown and receive your diploma, the date is June 10th – 5 years after your high school graduation, but also a party date. Just a co-incidence again, and again your family turns the party into a graduation party. You get a job in your field and begin moving up the corporate ladder. Several years pass, and you meet the girl of your dreams, and eventually pop the question. She says “yes” and a date is set: May 27th. Wedding plans are finalized, and you are all set, until she hears that her brother has been deployed to Afghanistan and won’t be back by May 27th. After much calculation and debating, the wedding finally happens on June 21st. The significance of that date doesn’t occur to you until you’re standing in the church by the minister. You think “Wow! I’m getting married on one of the dates my Grandpa wrote down over 50 years ago. This is really weird” after my graduation from high school and college happening on these days “this has to be more than a co-incidence! What’s going on here?” The wedding goes on. You and your bride go on your honeymoon and life goes on. Pretty soon your wife announces that you are going to be a Daddy. Months pass and you start to wonder “If the important days of my life all happened on those “party dates” written long ago by Grandpa, is it possible that your child will be born on the next date? You get out the letter and see what the next date is: April 10th. “Is it really possible that the baby will be born on that date? How could Grandpa know?” The time comes, and sure enough, your baby arrives right on the day: April 10th. Now let me ask you a question: Would you be interested in what might happen on the next 3 party dates? Of course you would. You would lie awake at night wondering what comes next in your life, and what it all means.
