He added that Ulema should not be confused with the Islamic Ulema who teach Islamic law, or with the Allamah who were the leading Islamic figures of science and letters in medieval times.Farid Tayarah, an Ulema himself, and a former head of a Masonic Lodge stated that the Anakh was used during Masonic sessions and services.
