Their tenures were freehold, copyhold and leasehold. There were many leaseholds for three lives absolute (or freehold leases) holden under the archbishop of York, or the Church of Southwell.⁶² The whole midland district, including the counties of Leicester, Rutland, and Warwick, with the northern margin of Northamptonshire, the eastern portion of Staffordshire, and the southern extremities of Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire, is described by Marshall as abounding in yeomen of the highest class. Men cultivating their own estates, worth from two to five hundred pounds a year, were thickly scattered over almost every part of the district.
