

The modern psychiatric hospital may not be the antiquated venue of yore where patients were chained to the walls and staff were allowed to run amok performing lobotomies and other archaic techniques deemed necessary but the current system of psychiatric care has not, by any means, progressed into the advanced field where best practices set people free from their mental illness and patient centered environments help people face their problems on their own terms. The Practice of Bedlam chronicles the experiences of a psychotherapist in his last days as a practitioner at a modern day psychiatric hospital that likely provides services that are not too unlike the status quo of care provided in psychiatric hospitals everywhere. The businessization and medicalization of mental health treatment has created an unprecedented exploitation of the mental health field creating a system of sub-standard care where the best principles of psychology are disregarded and those who practice it are entered into subservient roles within a hierarchy of mental health governance that places business men and medically minded nurses or doctors at the top. When we wonder why mental health care seems to fail we should note that perhaps the wrong people with the wrong motives and wrong type of knowledge are often the ones making the decisions about the fields interests and therefore the greater societal interest of emotional health for everyone.
